

## Other Workforce Development Initiatives

### Center for Maternal & Child Health and Medicaid Partnerships State Technical Assistance Cohort

In March 2026, Kansas Title V was selected to participate in the second cohort of the Center for Maternal and Child Health and Medicaid Partnerships (CMMP) State Technical Assistance Cohort (STAC). Participation in this initiative provides Kansas with targeted technical assistance and peer-learning opportunities to strengthen collaboration between Title V and Medicaid programs.

During the remainder of FFY26 and throughout FFY27, the Title V Directors, Children and Families Section Director, and Family Systems Consultant will lead efforts to build a more robust and sustainable partnership with Medicaid. Priority areas of focus include strengthening coordination for medical home initiatives, enhancing data-sharing processes, and increasing meaningful family engagement in program planning and implementation.

This collaboration is expected to improve alignment across systems serving children and families, support more integrated service delivery, and advance shared maternal and child health goals across Kansas.
