BRIGHT SPOT

Staff were able to directly text a women who was currently homeless helpful resources including directions via Google map, hours of operation, and direct contact information.



BRIGHT SPOT

Staff talked with mom who was struggling with her 3-year-old's behavior. Call line staff reassured mom and together they identified some things she could try including connecting her to a local parenting class she could attend.



BRIGHT SPOT

A mom called in the middle of a panic attack. Her baby had not been sleeping well and she was exhausted. She had very little support at home. Staff were able to help her calm down and talked through some ideas to help her at home. Mom was also provided with local parenting support groups so she could connect to additional supports.
